

The University of Warsaw, Faculty of Economic Sciences is seeking candidates for a research assistant to work on the project “Modelling Multiple Social and Climate Tipping points”.

The project offers the opportunity to learn cutting-edge methods in economics: agent-based modelling and dynamics on networks, and to apply them to study policy-relevant questions.

We are looking for Ph.D. candidates to join our team working on social and climate tipping points. We will study policies that can help create networks of users of new technologies that may reduce global emissions and prevent climate change. Models will be developed using the agent-based method and the dynamics on networks.

We are looking for PhD and post-doc candidates to join our team. They will work closely with Prof. Karolina Safarzynska.

Requirements:

- Programming skills (Python, R, C++, other)
- Fluent English

Employment conditions:

Full-time employment for 4 years, starting from September-October 2023. Annual remuneration is PLN 60 000 free of taxes (PLN 5000 monthly). In addition, a candidate is obliged to enroll in the PhD school, where she/he may receive an additional stipend.
