The project aims to design and deliver an Intensive International Educational Programme that equips students and doctoral candidates with advanced competencies in applying Artificial Intelligence (AI) to business and financial analysis. It seeks to strengthen international didactic and research cooperation between the University of Warsaw and international universities, responding to the growing labour market demand for specialists combining expertise in finance, data analysis, and AI.
