The Oded Stark Award for outstanding publishing achievements.

Candidates: PhD students of the Faculty of Economic Sciences at the University of Warsaw and newly graduated doctors (no more than three years after the doctoral defence).

The amount of the award: 5,000 PLN. Award Criteria: Publication or acceptance of an article authored or co-authored by the award candidate, in an international peer-reviewed journal. Candidates for the award may submit more than one article.

The award committee will rank the submissions, and the candidate at the top of the list will receive the award. In the event of co-authorship of an article selected for the award, the award will be divided among the co-authors, if those individuals meet the criteria for candidates. The deliberations of the Committee are confidential.

The Award Committee: the Committee consists of two employees of the Faculty of Economic Sciences at the University of Warsaw, designated by the Dean: Professor Oded Stark and another professor employed at the Faculty.

The term of office of the Committee is three years, and its members may be reappointed for another term of office. Application deadline: 30 June, each year.

The award ceremony: the certificate and prize money will be presented in October each year, following the official announcement of the results. The recipient of the award will present the winning article at the first meeting of the doctoral seminar in a given academic year.
