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Erasmus+ 2026/2027

Information about the exchange

Who can go?

- Second year BA, first year MA and all PhD students can apply for Erasmus. Third year BA and second year MA can apply only in the additional recruitment for the second semester of their last year of studies.
- Each student for 12 months at each level of studies.
- At each academic year you have a right to only one exchange and one internship, which cannot overlap.
- 36 months of Erasmus in total: exchange + internships.
- If a student were already at exchange and wants to go again at the same level, you can use just the remaining months:

E.g. A Master student spent 5 months on exchange during his 1st year. In the 2nd year he has 7 months to use for exchange and/or internship.

Who can go?

University rules for 2026/2027:

- You cannot apply for Erasmus exchange if on the end of the application period you have more than one conditional pass.
- You cannot apply for Erasmus if you are retaking the year.
- If you have one conditional pass, you can apply, but your application will be considered as the last one.
- You cannot apply for the exchange taking place in the semester in which you have the retake of a course, due to a conditional pass – faculty rule.
- Erasmus scholarship in the academic year 2026/2027 will be awarded to students with the average grade not lower than 3.49.
- Students with lower average grade may apply for exchange but they will not obtain the scholarship. If their final average from 2025/2026 will be 3.49 or more, they can apply to IRO for funding.

Who can go?

Recommended language requirements are as follows:

- a) [Proof of language proficiency for student exchange purposes issued by The Centre for Foreign Language Teaching.](#)
- b) [Language Proficiency Certificate issued by The Centre for Foreign Language Teaching](#) or by any other Polish university.
- c) International certificate:
 - English: Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE); International English Language Testing System (IELTS); Test of English as a Foreign Language [TOEFL iBT®]
 - French: Diplôme d'Etudes en Langue Française (DELF B2), Diplôme approfondi de langue française (DALF C1, C2)
 - Spanish: Diploma de Español como Lengua Extranjera (DELE) Nivel B2;
 - German: Goethe-Zertifikat B2, Deutsches Sprachdiplom II (DSDII) B2, Österreichisches Sprachdiplom Deutsch B2 Mittelstufe Deutsch;
 - Russian: TRKI 2 (TORFL 2) Rosyjski państwo system certyfikacyjny z języka rosyjskiego dla obcokrajowców, Russkij jazyk povsednevnogo obščenija – certyfikat w zakresie języka rosyjskiego ogólnego: Postporogowyj uroven;
 - Italian: Certificato di Conoscenza della Lingua Italiana – Livello 3 (CELI 3).

Who cannot go?

Students who are nominated for the exchange loose the right to go:


- if they failed the year and have to repeat it,
- if they have more than one conditional pass from the academic year 2025/2026,
- if they have a conditional pass and have the retake of a course in the semester in which they are supposed to be on the exchange,
- if they have another scholarship from the European Union which they do not want to give up.

You can quit at any moment, but it is better to do it earlier than later.

Where you can go?

- Agreements cover students' exchange for one or two semesters on one or all levels of studies, but the scholarships will be awarded only for one semester.
- All nominated students (for one or two semesters) are for the moment just candidates for the scholarship.
- Students nominated for one semester can apply for extension of the scholarship at the end of this semester (no scholarship?).
- You can only apply for the exchange through our agreements. You cannot apply through agreements of other faculties.
- We hope that there will be additional rounds of recruitment where you can use all University's agreements– coordinated by the IRO, not the faculty:
 - if you are nominated in the first round you cannot apply for other rounds.

Where you should go?

- You are going not for holidays but to study.
- Check the language level yourself.
- Look for universities with courses that are interesting for you.
- Check the key courses (e.g. https://www.wne.uw.edu.pl/student/programy_studiow/przedmioty-kluczowe) in the semester for which you want to go for exchange and first of all look for their equivalents.
- This equivalence must be approved by the coordinator of this course.
- For non-key courses you do not need equivalents. However, you should choose something close to your field of studies and I must approve it.
- 70% of ECTS points from the exchange must be for economic courses.
- You must bring at least 20 ECTS points from one semester exchange and you must have 60 ECTS points from the whole year.

Where you should go?

The Erasmus scholarship is awarded only for the time spent in the country of the host institution. In 2026/2027 most likely it will be the same as in 2025/2026, when it was equal to monthly:

- a) 670 EUR – Austria, Belgium, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden;
- b) 600 EUR – Bulgaria, Croatia, Lithuania, Northern Macedonia, Romania, Serbia, Turkey, Hungary.

In addition student receives a travel allowance depending on the distance and the mode of travel.

How to apply?

- We will announce when we start application procedure when the IRO announces the rules of Erasmus for the next year.
- You will submit applications in USOS and an application form (scan), available from our Erasmus website.
- You can find all relevant information on [our Erasmus website](#).
- The faculty will nominate students for exchange, but it is not equivalent with awarding them scholarships.
- Disabled students may apply for additional funds based on the real costs.
- We do not know how much money the university will receive. If not enough for all nominated students, the rector will introduce additional recruitment criteria.
- Before you depart you will have to write the language test in the language of studies of the host institution.
