Dear Students,

We encourage all students to use the newly opened health clinics at Warsaw. Each foreign student may benefit from the clinic on the principles set out below.

1. Students from EU countries

Free medical services are granted on the following grounds:

- students possess a valid European Health Insurance Card



2. Students from non-EU countries:

a) Free medical services are granted on the following grounds:

- students possess a valid KARTA POLAKA (Polish Card)



or

- possession of an individually signed contract with the Polish National Health Service (NFZ) along with the application for Social Security as well as proof of payment of the insurance Premium (46,80 zł/monthly)

The scope of medical services:

- basic medical care from doctor / nurse
- referrals for necessary diagnostic and laboratory tests
- Issuance of prescriptions for reimbursed drugs and medicine
- issuance of referrals to specialists, hospital
- information about how to proceed in the diagnosis and treatment

Students who have the above mentioned documents can benefit from medical services in all Warsaw Centermed offices and a full range of primary care services during regular hours of operation.
