The competition is open to persons who meet the requirements set in forth in the Act on Higher Education of July 20, 2018 (consolidated text: Journal of Laws 2018, item 1668, as amended)

Candidate should have a PhD in Economics and at least several years of experience in teaching in the area of economy which allows the candidate to conduct classes in Polish and English. We expect that the Candidate is knowledgeable in the general area of business informatics and quantitative methods. Furthermore, the Candidate should have a strong background in advanced data analysis techniques and experience in working with big data. The Candidate should be able to conduct teaching in advanced quantitative methods (e.g., data mining) and programming languages, especially Python and/or R. The requirements include also experience in scientific research, confirmed by publication record in international journals or conferences. We also expect willingness to active pursuing and conducting scientific research projects. Documented scientific, didactic and international achievements (e.g., work experience at a foreing research institution, conferences or research projects) will be important arguments during the recruitment procedure
