- an outstanding track record of scientific achievements (high quality research, documented with, among others, scientific publications in internationally recognized, peer reviewed journals, with a high *impact factor*) relative to their career stage
- experience in utilizing quantitative methods for scientific research
- experience in managing and attracting research projects
- willingness to teach in English or Polish

The position is 45% Research, 45% Teaching, 10% Administration.
The candidate must have wide international research experience
