- **Detailed information on how to register will be given at the meeting for 1st year students.**
- **Choice limit means the maximum number of courses you can choose from a given group of courses (excluding mandatory courses)**
- **We kindly request that you give your choice careful consideration before registering. Please note there will be no possibility of withdrawal from a course after the main registration period is closed, except the case described in the Regulations of Studies at the University of Warsaw §32 section 3. As a result, students will be obliged to obtain a passing score for each course they have registered for.**
- Registration for courses results in an immediate display of your place in a course group and inclusion of the course into your course schedule (except the registration periods with possibility of exceeding group limit / creating queues). Therefore, you can update your choices as long as the registration period is open (i.e. withdraw – if the registration period provides this possibility). As the registration period terminates, no changes are made to the lists available in USOSWeb. Termination of this period is followed by assignment of students whose requests have been approved to groups they indicate. In registration periods with possibility of exchange places between groups all possible exchanges will be made immediately.
- Students assigned to a given group in the first registration period retain their group placement in the next registration period unless they later withdraw from the course (if the registration period provides such possibility).
- **In the case of a decision to close courses / groups due to insufficient number of students, in case of mandatory courses, students are registered to other groups of the same courses, in case of elective courses, students are unregistered from such courses.**
